- ◆ All volunteers MUST check-in at the volunteer check-In center (this year located inside the Park Program Center). Then you will receive your directions and assignment.
- ◆ All volunteers are encouraged to enjoy the festival as they help visitors do the same. Our goal is to provide friendly directions and assistance to any Ice Festival visitor who needs it. Congeniality and safety is essential!
